

**ORDINANCE 2018-22**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) AND THE STREETS INFRASTRUCTURE/EQUIPMENT FUND (2012) AND AUTHORIZING AN ADVANCE FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE STREET INFRASTRUCTURE/EQUIPMENT FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Administrator has advised the Council that the Street Department is in need of a new UTV to replace the ~~2000 Kubota BX2350~~ and 1982 Yamaha golf cart which have a lot of hours and is in need of repair; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds needed for the purchase of a Kubota UTV in the amount of \$23,225.50 are not available within the Street Department 2018 permanent appropriations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Administrator has requested to advance funds from the General Fund to the Street Infrastructure/Equipment Fund until revenue from the income tax levy can build up to repay the advance needed for a new UTV which now necessitates an increase in the appropriations.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

**SECTION 1:** The permanent appropriations in the General Fund are \$1,151,882.61. An additional \$23,225.50 must be appropriated for the new Kubota UTV. An increase in the total appropriations in the General Fund Advances Out line 1000-920-920-0006 in the amount of \$23,225.50 is authorized. The new permanent appropriations in the General Fund will be 1,175,108.11.

**SECTION 2:** The permanent appropriations in the Street Infrastructure/Equipment Fund are \$15,000. An additional \$23,225.50 must be appropriated for the new Kubota UTV. An increase in the total appropriations in the Street Infrastructure/Equipment Fund 2012-620-432-0000 in the amount of \$23,225.50 is authorized. The permanent appropriations in the Street Infrastructure/Equipment Fund will be increased by \$23,225.50 resulting in the appropriations changing from \$15,000 to \$38,225.50.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor in order to fund the purchase of a Kubota UTV in advance of the start of plowing season.

**SECTION 4:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
