

ORDINANCE 2018-24

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE DRUG LAW ENFORCEMENT FUND (2081) FOR THE POLICE K-9 PROGRAM BY \$2,500 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram Police Department has established a K-9 Fund 2081 to receive donations to help secure a K-9 program to benefit the Village of Hiram and as appropriate surrounding areas; and

WHEREAS, the Village Police Chief has requested the authority to utilize \$2,500 of the funds collected to purchase materials and equipment that is anticipated to help in marketing to generate additional funds through fundraising in support of the K-9 program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the DRUG LAW ENFORCEMENT Fund (2081) are \$745.75 with ZERO appropriated in the Police K-9 line item 2081-110-420-0999. An increase of \$ 2,500 in new appropriations is hereby approved resulting in a new appropriated amount in the Police K-9 line item of \$ 2,500 and new total appropriations of 3,245.75 in Fund 2081.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because time is of the essence. Fundraising projects, grants and end of year donations from businesses are vital to the established K-9 Fund Program.


