

ORDINANCE 2020-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS IN SEVERAL FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A HYDRAULIC LIFT IN THE SERVICE GARAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, James McGee, Village Administrator for the Village had informed Finance that the existing hydraulic lift in the service garage is in poor condition and is dangerous to use; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator informed Finance that given the fact the service garage performs regular routine maintenance on Village of Hiram equipment including vehicles and equipment for the police, water and sewer departments, that the purchase of a hydraulic lift be divided by these departments with \$2,000.00 from the Police Department budget and the balance in equal shares from the Service, Water and Sewer Department budgets; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council passed Resolution 2019-41 at the December 10, 2019 Council meeting authorizing the Village Administrator to purchase a hydraulic lift and installation with a total expenditure not to exceed \$25,000.00. The Village Administrator has since received a final estimated price for the lift and installation of \$24,204.25; and

WHEREAS, to meet these obligations several funds will need to have their appropriations increased.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The following chart outlines the authorized amendments to the enumerated funds:

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow for the timely purchase and installation of the hydraulic lift in order for the service garage to begin utilizing the lift for the regular maintenance of Village equipment to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
