

ORDINANCE 2020-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND (5702) FOR SEWER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has advised the Finance Committee that the Sewer Department has been experiencing multiple issues with the current pump at the 700 lift station; and

WHEREAS, The Village Administrator has indicated there should always exist a replacement pump in the case of a sewer pump failure; and

WHEREAS, the funds needed to purchase two new hydromatic grinder pumps and various installation parts for the Sewer Department in the amount of \$20,000.00 are not available within the Sewer Department 2020 operating appropriations; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has requested to use funds in the Sewer Capital Improvements Fund which now necessitates an increase in the appropriations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: The temporary appropriations in the Sewer Capital Improvements Fund are \$7,500.00. An additional \$20,000.00 must be appropriated for the updates to the sewer plant infrastructure. The total appropriation in the Sewer Capital Improvements Fund 5702-800-590-0000 in the amount of \$20,000.00 is authorized.

SECTION 2: The temporary appropriations for the Sewer Capital Improvements Fund will be increased by \$20,000.00 resulting in the appropriations changing from \$7,500.00 to \$27,500.00.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor in order for the Village Administrator to expedite the required updates to the Village's sewer infrastructure and to preserve the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Hiram.


SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
