

ORDINANCE 2020-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE HIRAM COMMUNITY TRUST GRANTS FUND (2902) BY \$2804.61 FOR PARK INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS AND MAINTENANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has indicated to the Park Board the ongoing need for infrastructure improvements, repairs and maintenance to the Village parks including the replacement of the corkscrew slide at Jagow Park and a sealcoat on the Hike and Bike trail; and

WHEREAS, the Park Board held their meeting by way of video teleconference on Thursday, May 7, 2020 to discuss the infrastructure improvements and maintenance needed at the three parks owned and operated by the Village of Hiram; and

WHEREAS, the Park Board passed a motion to request the permanent appropriations for the Hiram Community Trust Grants Fund 2902 be increased by the funds available to be utilized by the Village Administrator; and

WHEREAS, to meet these obligations, Fund 2902 will need to have its appropriations increased.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The following chart outlines the authorized amendment to the enumerated fund:


