

ORDINANCE 2020-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) FIRE DEPARTMENT (120) FOR THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION'S SAFETY INTERVENTION GRANT PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram Fire Department has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$6,341.72 from the Ohio BWC Safety Intervention Grant Program to be used to purchase protective hoods and gloves for the fire equipment; and

WHEREAS, this grant involves a 5 to 1 cost share, meaning the Ohio BWC is funding \$5,284.77 and the Village of Hiram is responsible for \$1056.95, of which no more than \$1,056.95 will be used from the Fire Department operations budget to purchase the protective hoods and gloves; and

WHEREAS, a special line item in the General Fund (1000-120-400-1305) has been established to account for the appropriation of these funds; and

WHEREAS, appropriations will need to be increased in order for the Fire Department to begin using these grant funds as soon as they are received by the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, a majority or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the General Fund for the Fire Department (1000-120) are \$156,799.28 and need to be increased to \$162,084.05. The funds being placed in this fund are grant funds.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor being the grant has already been applied for and the Village of Hiram Fire Department has been awarded the grant and for the further reason that the grant funds received must be spent within a ninety-day timeframe.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.




