ORDINANCE 2020-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE WATER OPERATING FUND (5101) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Water Department has received numerous complaints over the condition of the water that is supplied to Wrenwood Drive, a private drive in the Village of Hiram; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator brought this concern to the Finance Committee to determine a solution which is to replace the waterline so that it is more suitably sized for the two homes that occupy Wrenwood Drive and with the new line, allow it to be flushed periodically to remove sediment and discoloration; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the Water Operating funds, the Village Administrator determined that more appropriations will be needed to cover the replacement of the waterline by \$15,000; and

WHEREAS, at the Finance Committee meeting, a motion passed unanimously to move forward with the waterline replacement and have the water operating appropriations amended to cover the anticipated costs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village Of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The permanent appropriations in the Water Operating Fund are \$245,362.81 with \$66,760.00 in Personnel Services and \$178,602.81 in Other Operations. Line 5101-539-399-0000 for Other Contractual Services will be increased by \$15,000.

SECTION 2: The new total appropriations in Other Operations will be \$193,602.81. The new total appropriations for the Water Operating Fund (5101) will be \$260,362.81.

SECTION 3: this Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to cover the costs of the waterline replacement to pay the contractor in a timely manner in order to provide safe drinking water for the Village residents.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
