

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-02

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A LIMITED EASEMENT TO OHIO EDISON COMPANY FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF FIXTURES AND APPURTENANCES FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRIC CURRENT WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram has received requests from Ohio Edison Company, a public utility, for two easements on Wakefield Road, a dedicated public street within the Village of Hiram; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram has considered the request and has determined that it is in the public interest to grant to Ohio Edison one limited easement, so as to permit Ohio Edison to maintain and upgrade the electric infrastructure within the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, State of Ohio two thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1: Upon payment for the easement in the amount of \$1,000.00 the Village Administrator is authorized to execute the easement in substantial conformity with that set forth as Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein and by reference.

SECTION 2: It is found that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon the earliest time provided by law.
