

ORDINANCE 2021-05

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A GRANT AND AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) AND AUTHORIZING AN ADVANCE FROM THE GENERAL FUND (1000) TO THE BODY ARMOR GRANT FUND (2275) OF \$1,866.75 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Chief for the Village of Hiram presented the Fiscal Officer with information that the Hiram Police Department has been successful in their efforts to secure a grant through the State of Ohio's Bullet Proof Vest Program; and

WHEREAS, the Bullet Proof Vest Grant (BVP) is a reimbursing grant so funds will need to be advanced from the General Fund to the Body Armor Grant Fund in order to purchase the vests and then submit to the State for re-imbusement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The grant is accepted.

SECTION 2: The current appropriations in the general Fund are \$888,973.42. With the addition of \$1,866.75, the new appropriations will be \$890,840.17.

SECTION 3: The breakdown of the increase will be as follows: The advances out will be increased by \$1,866.75. In the General Fund, line item 1000-920-920-0918 will be used for the advance of \$1,866.75 to the Body Armor Grant Fund, line item # 2275-941-0000.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the Chief of Police to begin using the grant funds to provide for the health and safety of the police officers of Hiram Village.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formation action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

PASSED IN COUNCIL as an emergency on April 13, 2021.
