ORDINANCE 2021-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CONTINUED PROFESSIONAL TRAINING SPECIAL REVENUE FUND (2272) BY \$1,000.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Chief for the Village of Hiram presented the Fiscal Officer with information that the Hiram Police Department has increased its 2021 police department training due to the 2020 COVID-19 Pandemic cancellation of in-person training courses throughout the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has requested the permanent appropriations in the Professional Training Fund be amended to cover additional in-person training.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the Continuing Professional Training Fund 2272-110-348-0117 (Attorney General training money for HPD) is \$2,500.00. An increase of \$1,000.00 in new appropriations is hereby approved resulting in a new total appropriation of \$3,500.00.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the Fiscal Officer to increase the "Continuing Professional Training Fund" to cover in-person training costs expended by the Police Department.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formation action were in meetings open to the public in compliances with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
