

ORDINANCE 2021-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) BY \$1,200 AND AUTHORIZING AN ADVANCE OF \$1,200 TO THE STATE EMS GRANT FUND (2062) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief informed the Fiscal Officer of an award of \$1,200.00 for an EMS Grant; and

WHEREAS, the EMS Grant is a reimbursing grant so money will have to be advanced from the General Fund to the EMS Grant Fund (2062).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The current appropriations in the General Fund are \$888,973.42. The appropriations need increased by \$1,200 in the other financing uses section, other operations. The new total appropriations in the General Fund will be \$890,173.42.

Section 2: The current appropriations in the Special Revenue EMS Grant Fund are \$0. The appropriations need increased by \$1,200 in 2062-120-420-0007. The new total appropriations in the Special Revenue Fund will be \$1,200.00.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the fire department to begin using the grant funds to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

Section 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
