

ORDINANCE 2023-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) BY \$3,984.00 AND THE REVENUE AND PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CONTINUED PROFESSIONAL TRAINING SPECIAL REVENUE FUND (2272) BY \$3,984.00 AND \$7,968.00 RESPECTIVELY AND AUTHORIZING AN ADVANCE FROM THE GENERAL FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Chief for the Village of Hiram presented the Fiscal Officer with information that the Hiram Police Department will be reimbursed 100% per officer from the Ohio Attorney General's Office for the 24 hours of State mandated Continued Professional Training for 2023; and

WHEREAS, the General Fund will need to advance \$3,984.00 to the Special Revenue Fund (2272) to cover the training until the Ohio Attorney General reimburses the Village for the training hours; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has requested the permanent appropriations in that fund be amended to cover additional personnel/salary expenditures.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the General Fund are \$822,422.87. The appropriations need increased by \$3,984.00 in 1000-920-920-0004 the advances-out line item. The new total appropriations in the General Fund will be \$826,406.87.

SECTION 2: The current revenue budget for Fund 2272 is ZERO. An increase of \$3,984.00 to accept the Ohio Attorney General's office training monies is hereby approved.

SECTION 3: The current appropriations in Fund 2272 Continuing Professional Training is \$1,232.65. An increase of \$3,984.00 for Personal Services/Payroll Deductions of new appropriations is hereby approved.

SECTION 4: The current appropriations in line 2272-920-920-0117 Advances-out will need to be increased by \$3,984.00 to cover the advance back to the General Fund once funds are reimbursed from the Ohio Attorney General's office which are hereby approved resulting in a total appropriation in Fund 2272 of \$9,200.65.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the Police Department to begin professional training hours for its officers to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 6: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formation action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

PASSED IN COUNCIL as an emergency on September 12, 2023.
