

ORDINANCE 2023-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) BY \$2,975.04 AND THE REVENUE AND PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE STATE EMS GRANT FUND (2062) BY \$2,975.04 AND \$5,950.08 RESPECTIVELY AND AUTHORIZING AN ADVANCE FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE STATE EMS GRANT FUND (2062) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief informed the Fiscal Officer of an award of \$2,975.04 for an EMS Grant; and

WHEREAS, the EMS Grant is a reimbursing grant so money will have to be advanced from the General Fund to the EMS Grant Fund (2062).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The current appropriations in the General Fund are \$826,406.87. The appropriations need increased by \$2,975.04 in 1000-920-920-0013 the advances-out line item. The new total appropriations in the General Fund will be \$829,381.91.

SECTION 2: The current revenue budget for Fund 2062 is \$500. An increase of \$2,975.04 to accept the State EMS Grant is hereby approved. The revised revenue budget will be \$3,475.04.

SECTION 3: The current appropriations in Fund 2062 State EMS Grant is \$500.00. An increase of \$2,975.04 in Operating Supplies and Materials (EMS Dept.) of new appropriations is hereby approved.

SECTION 4: The current appropriations in line 2062-920-920-0013 Advances-out will need to be increased by \$2,975.04 to cover the advance back to the General Fund once funds are reimbursed from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services (EMS).

SECTION 5: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the fire department to begin using the grant funds to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 6: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
