

ORDINANCE 2024-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram entered into a settlement agreement with Wendelin Taylor with the elimination of the position of Assistant Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Taylor has applied for and was granted unemployment compensation upon the final payout of her settlement agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram is a reimbursing employer under the Ohio unemployment compensation guidelines and as such does not pay out any unemployment premiums until utilized by a previous employee; and

WHEREAS, to meet the obligations of the Village, the General Fund will need to have its appropriations increased.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The following chart outlines the authorized amendment to the enumerated fund:


Fund	Fund Name	Current Appropriations	Additional	New Appropriation
1000	General Fund	\$ 817,522.76	\$ 9,906.00	\$ 827,428.76

SECTION 2: The breakdown of the increase in appropriations will be as follows: In the General Fund, line item 1000-725-240-0000 will be increased by \$9,906.00.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the Village of Hiram to continue to function and pay their obligations to provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.


SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

PASSED IN COUNCIL as an emergency on October 8, 2024.
