

RESOLUTION 2024-26

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND SUBSEQUENT ACCEPTANCE OF ODNR GRANT FUNDS BY THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM AND RATIFYING PAST ACTIONS WHICH ARE NOW AUTHORIZED BY THIS RESOLUTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Natural Resources is making funding available to Ohio safety agencies for the purpose of “Step Outside Grant” to be used for Hiram PD “Cops and Kids Fishing Day” event; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram is likely to be a successful candidate upon application for the grant funds being made available.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The action of the Police Chief of the Village of Hiram in applying for the available grants for \$500.00 are ratified and approved.

SECTION 2: The Council of the Village of Hiram authorizes the Fiscal Officer to accept funds from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources in the event the Hiram Police Department is a successful grant recipient.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the particular emergency being the grant application is being made available June 1st and must be submitted within 60 days of the event. The, “Cops and Kids Fishing Day” event will be August 17, 2024.

SECTION 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


