

RESOLUTION 2024-28

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE PURSUANT TO THE NATUREWORKS GRANT PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (“ODNR”) administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the State of Ohio NatureWorks Grant program; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires financial assistance under the NatureWorks Grant Program for its Jagow Park Improvements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The Village Council hereby approves the filing of an application for financial assistance from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (“ODNR”).


SECTION 2: That the Mayor is further authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the ODNR and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

SECTION 3: That the Village does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of this NatureWorks Grant Program.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason that the application need be submitted timely in order to be eligible for the ODNR NatureWorks Grant Program, and providing this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by two-thirds (2/3) of the Council and approval by the Mayor.



PASSED IN COUNCIL as an emergency on August 13, 2024.


