

RESOLUTION 2014-07

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 1988 EMERGENCY-ONE FIRE TRUCK FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FROM THE CITY OF AURORA AND RATIFY PAST ACTIONS WHICH ARE NOW AUTHORIZED BY THIS RESOLUTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram Fire Department currently is in need of a fire truck; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram Fire Department has researched the purchase of a new or used fire truck; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has a used fire truck for purchase for \$15,000, which representatives of the Village Fire Department have determined to be in good condition and which can be adapted to meet the requirements of the Hiram Village Fire Department.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The actions of the Village of Hiram Fire Department personnel in selecting, investigating, negotiating and coordinating the purchase of the a 1988 Emergency-One Fire Truck from the City of Aurora are hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.


SECTION 2: The Council of the Village of Hiram authorizes the purchase from the City of Aurora of a 1988 Emergency-One Fire Truck.

SECTION 3: The payment of \$15,000.00 for the purchase of the fire truck and \$10,000 for equipment upgrades is authorized.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution be declared an emergency measure becoming immediately effective upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because this fire apparatus is needed for public safety.


