

**RESOLUTION 2008 -09**

**A RESOLUTION INITIATING AN AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 1210 of the Zoning Code of the Village of Hiram has been adopted to set forth a procedure to adopt amendments to the Zoning Code of the Village of Hiram; and

**WHEREAS**, section 1210.002 of the Hiram Zoning Code sets forth three options through which zoning amendments may be initiated; and

**WHEREAS**, section 1210.002 indicates that one of the options for initiating an amendment to the Village of Hiram Zoning Code is by the adoption of a resolution by the Village Council.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council for the Village of Hiram, County of Portage, State of Ohio, a majority of the members thereto concurring, that:

**Section 1.** At an Ordinance amending the Hiram Village Zoning Code by creating a transferable development rights program should be initiated.


**Section 2.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 3.** That this Ordinance be declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because this will allow the review of the proposed transferable development rights program amendment to the Hiram Zoning.
