

RESOLUTION 2008-10

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 2009 PROPOSED BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO SUBMIT THE BUDGET TO THE PORTAGE COUNTY AUDITOR .

WHEREAS, the Hiram Village Council, Hiram, Ohio shall adopt the 2009 budget by July 15, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the 2009 budget projections for the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio must be submitted to the County Auditor by July 20, 2008; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing must be held prior to the submission of the budget to he County Auditor; and

WHEREAS, said hearing will be held on June 10, 2008 fifteen minutes prior to the regularly scheduled council meeting in Village Council Chambers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: Hiram Village Council hereby approves the 2009 budget, said approval having been given in light of the discussion of the budget at the public hearing and during Council meetings; and instructs the Fiscal Officer to send two copies of the 2009 budget to the County Auditor prior to July 20, 2008.



Second Reading & Public Hearing: June 10, 2008


Third Reading: June 10, 2008
