

RESOLUTION 2008-14

A RESOLUTION GRANTING AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION TO VIEW A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 1210.006(B) of the Village of Hiram Zoning Code indicates that the Planning Commission shall have no less than thirty (30) days, no more than sixty (60) days from the date of referral by Council to prepare a recommendation on any proposed amendment to the Zoning Code of the Village of Hiram; and

WHEREAS, Section 1210.006(B) provides that a time extension of time up to an additional sixty (60) days may be authorized by Council when necessary; and


WHEREAS, the proposed amendment to the Village of Hiram Zoning Code establishes the transfer of development rights, which is an amendment of far reaching consequence and which requires more time, attention and study than the Planning Commission accomplish within the initial sixty (60) day period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:


SECTION 1: The Planning Commission is granted an additional sixty (60) days beyond the original sixty (60) day period from date of referral by council, within which to consider an amendment to the zoning code with respect to the transfer of development rights.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all the deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


