

Resolution 2012-40

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW SPECIAL REVENUE FUND (2275) BODY ARMOR GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Hiram Police Department has been informed they will be the recipient of a grant from the United States Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, these grant funds will be used to purchase body armor for the Police Department in 2013.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, a majority or more of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The purpose of this fund is to receipt the grant funds in to purchase the body armor.

SECTION 2: In Resolution 2012-27 Council authorized the Fiscal Officer to accept funds from the United States Department of Justice in the event the department was successful in their attempt.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
