

Resolution 2012-46

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SPECIFIC ENUMERATED TRANSFERS BY THE FISCAL OFFICER BETWEEN FUNDS OF THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM FROM THE SEWER FUND (5201) TO THE SEWER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (5702) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has determined funds need to be set aside for future improvements in the utility departments; and

WHEREAS, there are funds available to be set aside.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: \$55,000 transferred from the Sewer Fund (5201-910-910-0104) to the Sewer Capital Improvement Fund (5702-931-0000).


SECTION 2: This Resolution is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the transfer to happen in a prompt and appropriate way and remain within the constraints of this year's budget as well as provide for the health and safety of the residents of the Village of Hiram.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.




