RESOLUTION 2012-47

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF THE 2007 FORD CROWN VICTORIA AND 2002 FORD TAURUS POLICE CRUISER OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15 authorizes municipalities to sell personal property no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has indicated that 2007 Ford Crown Victoria and 2002 Ford Taurus police cruisers are no longer needed by his department and that each car has a scrap value of approximately \$650.00; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Fire Department has indicated that prior to being sold for scrap the 2007 Ford Crown Victoria and 2002 Ford Taurus police cruisers could be used by the Fire Department for rescue training purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram wishes to authorize through this Resolution the sale of the 2007 Ford Crown Victoria and 2002 Ford Taurus police cruisers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Hiram, County of Portage and State of Ohio, a majority of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The Council hereby authorizes the use of the 2007 Ford Crown Victoria and 2002 Ford Taurus police cruisers for rescue training by the Fire Department.

SECTION 2: After the use of the 2007 Ford Crown Victoria and 2002 Ford Taurus police cruisers for rescue training the Village Council has determined that both cars are no longer needed for any municipal purpose.

SECTION 3: The Council determines that after the use of the 2007 Ford Crown Victoria (VIN # 2FAFP71W67X102681) and 2002 Ford Taurus (VIN # 1FAFP53212A159337) police cruisers for rescue training the value of the cars is \$650.00 each and the sale of each of the cars for that amount is authorized.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that all deliberations of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 5: This Resolution is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor for the reason that the Fire Department needs to conduct the rescue training as soon as possible and that the vehicles should be sold as soon as possible after the training is completed.
