

**RESOLUTION 2014-26**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND SUBSEQUENT ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS BY THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM AND RATIFYING PAST ACTIONS WHICH ARE NOW AUTHORIZED BY THIS RESOLUTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, division of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) is making funding available to Ohio EMS agencies for the purpose of purchasing emergency medical equipment and for EMS training; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Hiram is likely to be a successful candidate upon application for the grant funds to be made available.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

**SECTION 1:** The Fire Chief of the Village of Hiram has applied for the available grants for purchasing EMS equipment and for EMS training.

**SECTION 2:** That the Council of the Village of Hiram authorizes the Fiscal Officer to accept funds from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of EMS because Hiram Fire Department is a successful grant recipient.


**SECTION 3:** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the particular emergency being the grant has already been applied for and the Village of Hiram Fire Department has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$3,750.

**SECTION 4:** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


