

RESOLUTION 2014-39

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO AN ADDENDUM TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF HIRAM TO PROVIDE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT WITHIN THE GEOGRAPHIC AREA CONSISTING OF HIRAM TOWNSHIP AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram and the Township of Hiram have previously entered into an Agreement for traffic enforcement services beginning on July 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Enforcement Agreement provided for an automatic increase in the hours of service beginning on January 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Township has requested that the Village agree to a deferral of the increase of the traffic enforcement service hours for a period of three months beginning on January 1, 2015 and ending on March 30, 2015.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The Mayor and the Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement with the Township of Hiram for traffic enforcement services, said Agreement to be substantially in conformity with the terms and conditions as are found in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor to allow the Hiram Police Department to continue to provide services to Township of Hiram at the current level all to the benefit of the health and safety of the residents of both the Village of Hiram and Hiram Township.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that the deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public sale in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


