

RESOLUTION 2017-07

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADVERTISING FOR BIDS FOR COLLECTION SERVICE OF SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLABLE SOLID WASTE WITHIN HIRAM VILLAGE, PORTAGE COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram has determined that the health, safety and welfare of the community will be advanced by using a single residential solid waste collection service for solid waste and a single residential service for recyclable materials and to accomplish that end has enacted Chapter 941 of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with Hiram Township (hereinafter Township), the Council of the Village of Hiram has caused bid specifications for solid waste and recyclable materials collection service to be generated; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram has determined that the matter of who should be the single provider of solid waste collection services and the single provider of recyclable collection services within the Village (and with the concurrence of the Township also in the Township) should be advertised for bid forthwith and that actions in undertaking that advertisement should be ratified.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Hiram Village Council, two thirds or more of its members concurring that:

SECTION 1: Advertisement for recyclable material solid waste collection service within the Village of Hiram and Hiram Township in substantial conformity with the bid specifications attached hereto and marked for identification as Exhibit "A" is hereby authorized.


SECTION 2: Advertisement for solid waste collection service within the Village of Hiram and Hiram Township in substantial conformity with the bid specifications attached hereto and marked for identification as Exhibit "B" is hereby authorized.

SECTION 3: That the actions taken by the Village Administration in concert with Hiram Township are authorized, and the actions taken in advance of the passage of this Resolution are ratified, confirmed and approved.


SECTION 4: That this Resolution be declared an emergency measure becoming immediately effective upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor in order to advance the health, safety, morals and general welfare of the citizens of the Village and for the further reason that the competitive bidding is now underway in conjunction with bidding for the same services by Hiram Township so that economies of scale can be realized by the combined bid package.

SECTION 5: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that the deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


