

RESOLUTION 2017-32

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND SUBSEQUENT ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS BY THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM AND RATIFYING PAST ACTIONS WHICH ARE NOW AUTHORIZED BY THIS RESOLUTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice is making funding available to Ohio Safety agencies for the purpose of purchasing body armor; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram is likely to be a successful candidate upon application for the grant funds being made available.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:


SECTION ONE: The action of the Police Chief of the Village of Hiram in applying for the available grants for the purchase of body armor for \$10,000.00 are ratified and approved.

SECTION TWO: The Council of the Village of Hiram authorizes the Fiscal Officer to accept funds from the United States Department of justice as the Hiram Village Police Department is a successful grant recipient.


SECTION THREE: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the particular emergency being that the grant application deadline was August 31, 2017, the grant was applied for and the Village has been awarded \$7,353.44 for the purchase or body armor.

SECTION FOUR: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.




