

RESOLUTION 2019-20

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND SUBSEQUENT ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS BY THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM FROM THE HIRAM COMMUNITY TRUST

WHEREAS, the Hiram Police Department would like to continue to provide resources for grant acquisition and fundraising for the Hiram K-9 Program; and

WHEREAS, the Hiram Police Department would like to make an application to the Hiram Community Trust for a \$1,000 grant to help cover the cost of a K-9 Training Bite Suit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The Hiram Village Council hereby supports the submission of an application to the Hiram Community Trust.

SECTION 2: The action of the Hiram Village Police Department in submitting an application for a grant to be purposed for the acquisition of a K-9 Training Bite Suit is hereby approved and confirmed.

SECTION 3: That in the event Hiram Village Police Department is a successful applicant, the Council of the Village of Hiram authorizes the Fiscal Officer to accept awarded funds from the Hiram Community Trust.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
