

RESOLUTION 2019-21

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND SUBSEQUENT ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS BY THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM FROM THE HIRAM COMMUNITY TRUST FOR THE ELMER JAGOW PARK BASKETBALL COURT.

WHEREAS, the Elmer Jagow Park basketball court is enjoyed by both Village and Township residents and that due to the continued use of the court and the Northeast Ohio seasonal weather conditions, it has come to the attention of the Village Administrator that the court surface, fencing and lighting are in need of upgrading or the court will become unusable; and

WHEREAS, the Hiram Village Administrator would like to submit a \$2,000 grant application to the Hiram Community Trust Board for the rehabilitation of the Elmer Jagow Park basketball court and the upgrade of the court lighting which will be matched, in kind, by the Village with materials, labor and equipment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The Hiram Village Council hereby supports and approves the action of the Village Administrator in his submission of a grant application to the Hiram Community Trust for \$2,000.

SECTION 2: That in the event the Hiram Village Administrator is a successful grant recipient, the Council of the Village of Hiram authorizes the Fiscal Officer to accept awarded funds from the Hiram Community Trust.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
