

RESOLUTION 2020-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND SUBSEQUENT ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS BY THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM FROM THE HIRAM COMMUNITY TRUST

WHEREAS, the Hiram Police Department would like to continue to provide assistance for underprivileged children and their families from the Crestwood and Garfield School Districts to enable them to give and receive Christmas gifts and food items that they would not otherwise have due to financial constraints; and

WHEREAS, the Hiram Police Department would like to make an application to the Hiram Community Trust for a \$2,000 grant to help cover the "Shop with a Cop" program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The Hiram Village Council hereby supports the submission of an application to the Hiram Community Trust for \$2,000.

SECTION 2: The actions of the Hiram Village Police Department in submitting an application for a grant to be purposed in the continued funding for the current and future "Shop with a Cop" program is hereby approved and confirmed.




