

RESOLUTION 2020-18

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITATIONS SET FORTH IN RESOLUTION 2020-16 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2020 the Council of the Village of Hiram passed Resolution 2020-16 to comply with the requirements of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136, (the CARES Act) which was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, to implement the CARES Act the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the CARES Act by passing Senate Bill 310 of the 133rd General Assembly (S.B. 310); and

WHEREAS, S.B. 310 requires subdivisions receiving funds under Section 1 of the act, to pass a resolution affirming that funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund may be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations before receiving said funds; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram has requested its share of funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That at the time of passage and as part of the usual legislative process the CARES Act was added to the United States Code as 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and the State of Ohio action was known as Senate Bill 310 of the 133rd General Assembly.

SECTION 2: That subsequent to passage and as part of the usual legislative process, CARES Act was codified and given a new citing reference.

SECTION 3: That subsequent to passage and as part of the usual legislative process, the State of Ohio legislation action then known as Senate Bill 310 of the 133rd General Assembly was given a new citing reference.

SECTION 4: The Village Council desires to acknowledge that the current citation for the CARES Act is in 42 U.S.C. 801(d), and the current citation for State of Ohio procedural direction is now known as House Bill 481 of the 133rd General Assembly.

SECTION 5: For all purposes, the references contained in Village Resolution 2020-16 are hereby amended to reference the correct citations to the CARES Act and the correct references to the State of Ohio procedural direction. In all other respects, Resolution 2020-16 is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.

SECTION 6: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 7: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the public health, safety, morals and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason that it is essential that the Village needs to demonstrate timely compliance with the requirements of the CARES Act.
