

RESOLUTION 2020-19

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND SUBSEQUENT ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS BY THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM AND RATIFYING PAST ACTIONS WHICH ARE NOW AUTHORIZED BY THIS RESOLUTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation's Safety Intervention Grant Program has made funding available to Firefighters for the purpose of protection against exposure to environmental elements by providing for protective gear to firefighting personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram is likely to be a successful candidate upon application for the grant funds to be made available.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Ohio, three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The Assistant Fire Chief of the Village of Hiram has applied for available grants to purchase Personal Protective Equipment. The Council hereby ratifies the actions taken by the Assistant Fire Chief in making said application.

SECTION 2: That the Council of the Village of Hiram authorizes the Fiscal Officer to accept funds from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation's Safety Intervention Grant Program because Hiram Fire Department is a successful grant recipient.


SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure, the particular emergency being the grant has already been applied for and the Village of Hiram Fire Department has been awarded a grant for \$6,341.72. This grant requires a 5 to 1 match, meaning the Ohio BWC is funding \$5,284.77 and the Village of Hiram is responsible for \$1,056.95, of which no more than \$1,056.95 will be used from the Fire Department operations budget to purchase protective hoods and gloves.

SECTION 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
