

**RESOLUTION 2020-23**

**A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO KIMBLE RECYCLING & DISPOSAL, INC. FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM, PORTAGE COUNTY, OHIO.**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Hiram has previously enacted legislation indicating that collection and disposal of public waste or garbage is a public utility, and shall be removed by a single service provider; and

**WHEREAS**, a bidding process has been authorized and undertaken to request bids for solid waste collection service within Hiram Village in conformity with law; and

**WHEREAS**, the advertisement for bids was published twice in the Record Courier, a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Hiram and Hiram Township; and

**WHEREAS**, Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc. was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for solid waste collection service in Hiram Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Hiram desires to award the contract for solid waste collection service within the Village of Hiram to Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc. in conformity with the bid submitted for a period of three years; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

**SECTION 1:** The bid submitted by Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc. is declared to be the lowest responsive and responsible bid for solid waste collection service within the Village of Hiram.

**SECTION 2:** That a contract in substantial conformity with the terms contained in the bid attached hereto and marked for identification as Exhibit "A" between Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc., the Village of Hiram and Hiram Township, is hereby authorized for a term of three full years commencing on September 1, 2020. The Mayor and the Fiscal Officer are directed to execute said contract.

**SECTION 3:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council and the Board of Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that the deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
