

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-02

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING TWO EASEMENTS FROM KEITH R. AND ELISA L. HOLMES FOR STORMWATER UTILITY ON REAL ESTATE LOCATED ON HINSDALE ROAD, A PUBLIC STREET WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram regularly maintains and as needed improves the stormwater system within the Village of Hiram; and

WHEREAS, as part of that ongoing maintenance and improvement the installation and/or replacement of a stormwater sewer must be undertaken by Hinsdale Road and on adjacent property owned by Keith R. and Elisa L. Holmes; and

WHEREAS, to perform the necessary work an easement is needed from Keith R. and Elisa L. Holmes, and Keith R. and Elisa L. Holmes have agreed to grant an easement for stormwater purposes to the Village of Hiram; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram wishes to accept the stormwater easements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: The permanent easement in favor of the Village of Hiram offered by Keith R. and Elisa L. Holmes as is set forth as Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein and by reference is accepted.

SECTION 2: The temporary easement in favor of the Village of Hiram offered by Keith R. and Elisa L. Holmes as is set forth as Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated herein and by reference is accepted.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced after the earliest time provided by law.
