

RESOLUTION 2023-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION FOR THE WAKEFIELD ROAD PUMP STATION IMPROVEMENTS, TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram is planning to make capital improvements, known as the Wakefield Road Pump Station Improvements, consisting of improvements to the pump station at the identified locations; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, two thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The Village Administrator and the Village Engineer are authorized to apply for and take additional actions as necessary to apply for financial aid from the Ohio Public Works Commission for the Wakefield Road Pump Station Improvements.

SECTION 2: The Mayor and the Fiscal Officer are authorized to enter into agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure, shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage, as it is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason to meet the deadlines associated with the applications for financial assistance.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that the deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
