

RESOLUTION 2024-16

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND SUBSEQUENT ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS BY THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM FROM THE 2024 CDBG COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ALLOCATION PROGRAM FOR ADA COMPLIANCE RENOVATIONS TO JAGOW PARK AND RATIFYING PAST ACTIONS WHICH ARE NOW AUTHORIZED BY THIS RESOLUTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram would like to upgrade Jagow Park with ADA walkways, ADA parking, ADA accessible borders and ramps, and ADA playground ground surface material to provide a fully ADA accessible facility to enable disabled individuals to play safely and gather in the Village of Hiram; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram is likely to be a successful candidate upon application for the grant funds being made available.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator submitted an application for the 2024 CDBG Community Development Allocation Program in the amount of \$130,296.00 to renovate Jagow Park with ADA compliant features.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The actions of the Village Administrator in applying for the available 2024 CDBG Community Development Allocation Program in the amount of \$130,296.00 are hereby ratified and approved.

SECTION 2: The Council of the Village of Hiram authorizes the Fiscal Officer to accept awarded funds from the CDBG Community Development Allocation Program.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the particular emergency being the grant has already been applied for by the Village Administrator.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
