

**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-32**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH T2 SYSTEMS FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPLEMENTING A PARKING VIOLATIONS ENFORCEMENT SYSTEM FOR THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Hiram seeks to implement a system that will streamline and enhance the Village of Hiram's ability to enforce its parking ordinances; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Hiram desires to contract with a third-party parking vendor to implement an enforcement system, when applicable, for parking in the Village of Hiram; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Hiram Administrator has negotiated a contract for parking enforcement with T2 Systems, a Verra Mobility Company, 3480 Gilmore Way, Suite 300, Burnaby, BC V5G4Y1 to customize a 36-month contract for the enforcement system; and

**WHEREAS**, The Village of Hiram Administrator has presented a contract, and the Village of Hiram Council finds the contract and its terms, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", to be favorable to the Village of Hiram and acceptable for purposes of parking enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Hiram wishes to proceed with the parking enforcement contract with T2 Systems.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds (2/3) or more of the members thereto concurring that:

**SECTION 1:** The Mayor and/or the Village Administrator are authorized on behalf of the Village of Hiram to execute the contract with T2 Systems, a Verra Mobility Company, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", with its addendum and Appendices.

**SECTION 2:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were accepted in an open meeting of this Council, and that deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3:** The Village of Hiram Council finds that this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure, effective immediately upon its passage in order to promote the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Hiram and for the further reasons that it is essential that the Village of Hiram secures a parking enforcement system as offered for the benefit of its residents.
